The set of races "MTB ALPINE CUP 2024" is made up of 4 MTB Marathon races.

RULES

The set of races MTB ALPINE CUP 2024 is made up of 4 MTB Marathon races taking place in France and Switzerland. These 4 races are scheduled on the UCI Marathon Series international calendar.

1. Registration

The starting blocks are established by each race according the UCI ranking. The amateurs will start from the first amateur starting block. The UCI delegate, with the agreement of the race chief and jury members, are allowed to change the starting order.

2. Classes and rankings

Ranking will be established according the following classes :

OPEN MEN (Elite – Under23) OPEN WOMEN (Elite – Under23)

Only runners who have fulfilled the following requirements are included in the ranking:

- Obligation to start on all 4 races
- 3 results minimum required
- Minimum of 300 points acquired to be officially classified
- If 4 results, no minimum points

Ranking points will be attributed according the following scoring scale:

| 200 for the 1st | 110 for the 13 th |

At the end of the 4 races set, the leader will be the one with more points.

Beyond the 100th place, the participant scores 1 point. The prize giving ceremony will be held after the last stage, La Forestière, France, 15 September 2024. In case of draw, the best ranking at the last race will determine the leader.

Participation to MTB Alpine Cup 2017 implies each competitor's respect of the rules of each race, the national cycling union's rules and the UCI's rules.

3. Prize

Every class leaders receive the MTB Alpine Cup 2019 jersey. For the ELITE/UNDER23 class from the 4 races set, the ten first will be rewarded with prize money according the following scale:

The three first ranks of the 3 races set will be rewarded with a diploma.

5. Protests

Possible protests must be lodged with the jury at the same time, according to the regulations of the UCI and the FFC.

6. ANNULATION

The organization committee reserves the right to modify the rules, the routes or the number of positive ascent at any time when circumstances require. The event will be held no matter the weather conditions as long as competitor's security is guaranteed. If the race has to be cancelled in the event of a reason beyond the organization's control, the registration will not be reimbursed or postponed to next year. Details will be given on event's website as well as during the race.

7. MODIFICATIONS

The organization committee reserves the right to modify the rules, at any time when circumstances require. The website of the event is the official source of information. Every official information will be communicate on the website of the event.

8. Responsibility

Mountain biking in general and mountainbiking competitions in particular represent a physical activity which involves risks. Each participant must enter the race knowing that he will ride on mountainous terrain with steep climbs and rapid descents and doing it on his own responsibility. Registration implies that participants give up asserting their rights against the organization and against every natural or legal person involved in the event. Moreover, with the registration participants prove their good physical conditions to assume a great effort.

9. Additional provision

For every case that is not mentioned in these rules, FCI 2017 and UCI rules will be the reference.

10. Registration

Registration implies that participants confirm:

- in case of disqualification, to have a medical certificate according ministerial decree 10.08.82; besides, the organization do not accept any responsibility in case of accident or helalth issue

- To have an license issued by a federation authorizing them to take part in cycling competitions

- To have a civil liability insurance
